
In August we will have a demonstration from a Golden Paint representative at our regular meeting. More details on this in the coming months.

Cindee Huwe gave a presentation on the use of colored pencils for lettering and backgrounds.












Renee Jorgensen joined us for our May meeting and demonstrated techniques for water color pencils which were used on contemporary decorated letters.
